Steven Johnston is a Crown Attorney with Alberta Justice, Specialized Prosecutions Branch in the Economic Crime Unit. He was called to the Bar in Manitoba in 1995 and practiced criminal defence work until joining Manitoba Justice in 2003 as a Crown Attorney. Steven was an economic crime prosecutor in Manitoba until he left Manitoba for the Chinook filled climate of Calgary in 2010. Steven has prosecuted, and defended cases at both trial and appellate levels. He has taught law enforcement in areas of economic crime, search and seizure and computer crime. He is presently a lecturer at the Canadian Police College in Ottawa on the DTIC, Network Investigators Course, and Internet Evidence Course. Steven has been the National Co-Chair of the Osgood Hall Technological Crime Course for the past three years.

Currently Steven prosecutes and advises on large scale financial crime cases in Calgary.
