Frédéric Gaudreau

Born in Montreal in 1974, Mister Gaudreau has been a police officer with the Sûreté du Québec since 1997. He presently holds the rank of Captain and serves as the officer in charge of the cybercrime unit, at the Criminal Intelligence Directorate. He began his career on patrol at the Lacolle detachment and then as a highway patrolman in the Mauricie. In 2001, he was assigned to temporary infiltration in order to exercise the duties of infiltration agent in the various spheres of organized crime and pressure groups. In 2002, he was assigned within the Criminal Intelligence Projects Service where he occupied the office of investigator in gaming integrity. In 2003, he was named officer in charge of the Cybersurveillance and monitoring unit where he coordinated several major investigation files as well as a multitude of development projects in partnership with organizations dedicated to the fight against cybercrime.

A Captain since September 2007, under the authority of the head of the Criminal Intelligence Directorate, he plans, organizes, manages and controls the activities inherent to the Cybercrime area.

Mr.Gaudreau represents the Sûreté du Québec on several committees and study groups such as the Canadian Federal/Provincial/Territorial study group on cybercrime, the Interpol specialist group on crime against children, and the *Association Francophone des Spécialistes en Investigation Numérique*. He is also member of the following steering committees: the *National Child Exploitation Coordination Center*, *Cybertip.ca*, and the *Child Exploitation Tracking System*, to whose development he actively contributed. He also represented the Sûreté du Québec during several symposiums and conventions in Québec, Canada and Internationally.

As regards his training, Mr Gaudreau holds a university certificate in applied police management and security, a university certificate in management of organizations and is presently completing a degree in Public Security.
